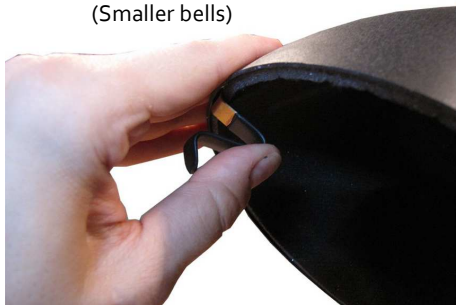
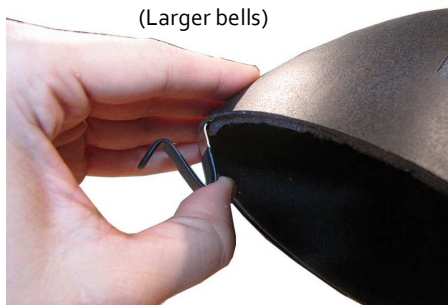


Trombone Soulo Mute Detailed Instructions

(Smaller bells)



(Larger bells)



1. Adjust the top two flexible clips to fit your bell size, while bracing the outer shell with your fingers.



2. With your left or right hand, grab the mute with your four fingers under the large clip. Place your thumb inside the mute on top of foam lining.



3. Slide the bell into the top two smaller clips.



4. Pull the bottom clip onto the bottom of the bell.



5. Adjust bottom clip to the open or closed position.
That's it!

Caring For Your Soulo Mute

We have designed Soulo Mute to withstand an impact from an accidental drop. As you will notice, the mute is also very flexible which prevents it from cracking under normal usage. However, there may be instances of extreme stress that would cause the mute to crack. For example, if it is placed under a very heavy object, it will most likely crack. In addition, hitting it hard with a blunt object will also cause it to crack.

We want your Soulo Mute to last you a long time. Here are a few suggestions based stress tests, as well as from customers, on how to protect it when traveling.

In this picture, a bubble mute is sitting on top of a plunger (not visible) inside Soulo Mute. This helps to consolidate space and protect both mutes from damage in a mute bag.



In this example, a cup from an adjustable cup mute is inside the clips of Soulo Mute to further protect it and help consolidate.
